



## Welcome to Oxford Sports Park ...

Oxford United Football Club would like to welcome you to this games programme event here at our new base at Oxford Sports Park.

OSP is a fantastic facility however there is still work in progress on some areas of the site. As a result we have a restricted usage permit in place that requires all users to adhere to the following rules whilst using the facility:

### On Arrival

#### **Car parking is on a first come first serve basis!**

#### **When the car park is full, spectators will need to find alternate parking!**

- Spectators are to REVERSE into all spaces and follow guidelines of the marshal team to ensure safe use of the car park.
- Spectators must stay within the clearly defined walkway and viewing areas at all time.
- **All persons must keep to the footpaths and not cut across any playing areas**
- Clear signage is displayed around the site – please ensure this is adhered to throughout.
- Spectators are advised that there are some areas of uneven ground. Please take care when moving around site.
- All viewing of matches is to take place from behind the appropriate orange barrier sections – pitch coordinators will direct you to the appropriate location.

### Players & Coaches

- Players are required to stay with their coaches **AT ALL TIMES** – access to the pitch will be made through the Blue Roped access points.
- Players will be walked to and from the changing rooms by OUFC staff and must remain together at all time.
- Any balls that cross the orange safety fencing are ONLY to be retrieved by full-time OUFC staff – no part-time staff, players or spectators are to cross the barriers at any time.

### Spectators

- All young children must be supervised at all times.
- This is a pet free site – no dogs are permitted on site with the exception of guide animals.
- This is a smoke free site – this includes the use of vapes and all tobacco-based products.
- Please use the bins provided to ensure we keep the site tidy.
- Toilet access is in the clearly marked facilities within the pavilion block.
- There is no spectator access to the OUFC building at this time. **In case of Fire**
- In the case of fire spectators, staff and players must report to the assembly area in the middle of the site – this is clearly marked on your map.

### On leaving the site

- All vehicles are to turn LEFT on leaving the site to ensure a safe flow of traffic at all times.
- All spectators, players and part-time staff must vacate the site NO LATER than 1:30pm
